Thank you for choosing International House Dublin! We hope you enjoy your stay with us. Please see some general guidelines below, for ensuring an enjoyable and safe stay in Dublin:

- Irish people drive on the left-hand side of the road. Therefore, always look left and right before crossing the road. Always use pedestrian crossings.
- Identity cards / passports are not needed for sightseeing in Dublin or coming to school. Leave them at your homestay, unless strictly necessary.
- Do not carry a lot of money with you.
- Be careful with your bags and wallets. Never leave them unattended. Do not leave money or valuables in your classroom during breaks.
- Always let somebody know where you are going and when you will be back.
- Shoplifting and theft of any kind are unacceptable in Ireland. Both will be dealt with by the police and will result in expulsion from the school.
- If you aren't feeling well and can't go to school, inform your host family and your Group Leader. You can also contact our emergency phone if you need any help.
- We do not tolerate any form of bullying at International House Dublin against students or staff. If you are a victim of bullying, please notify a member of staff immediately and we will deal with the problem. If you decide to bully other students or staff in the school, you will be reprimanded for your actions.

Host Families

An important part of your visit to Ireland is your stay with a host family. We are sure that you will be happy with your host family, but if you have any questions / concerns / problems, please inform your group leader and come to speak with our Accommodation Officer in the 3rd floor Admin Office, as soon as possible. Remember that staying at a homestay is not the same as staying in a hotel or guesthouse. It is your responsibility to make your bed in the morning and to keep your room tidy. Your host family will have been told what time you should return home in the evenings. You should try to spend as much time talking with your host family as possible and please show good manners by saying "please" and "thank you."

Academic Information

- Always participate in class.
- Don't be afraid to ask questions or to make mistakes.
- Talk to the staff and students from different countries. It's the best way to improve your English, make friends and have a good time.
- Take a little time each day to go over what you learned.
- Write down any language questions you have and ask your teacher the next day.
- If you have any problems or questions at all concerning your classes, level or homework, please speak to your teacher or a member of staff as soon as possible.
